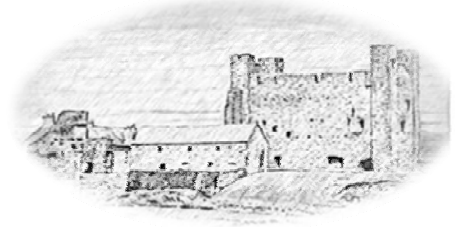


# GREENCASTLE AREA RESIDENTS GROUP



## Proposed Greenore-Greencastle Vehicle Ferry

A private company, Carlingford Lough Car Ferry Ltd, are in the planning stages for a Passenger & Vehicle Ferry crossing between Greencastle, Co. Down and Greenore, Co.Louth.

At a meeting of the Greencastle Area Residents Group (G.A.R.G) on Friday 14 October 2011 a sounding was taken from those present regarding their views on the proposed ferry. The views expressed were resoundingly opposed to the ferry – 90% opposed the introduction of the ferry.

The main arguments against the ferry are:

- Huge additional traffic volumes (up to 1000 cars per day)
- Inadequate road infrastructure
- Huge environmental impact
- Environmental pollution from the ferry, road traffic and service vehicles
- Industrialisation of Greencastle shoreline
- Noise pollution
- Reduction of property values along the main route to the ferry
- Danger to pedestrians, cyclists, motorists and livestock by increased traffic volumes.

The Greencastle Area Residents Group is planning a campaign to preserve Greencastle and its natural beauty and to oppose the introduction of the proposed ferry.
